

Supported log appenders

A log appender is a service utility which resides on the Operations server. This utility is responsible for writing logs (received by the Operations server from endpoints) to a single specific storage, as defined by the log appender's type. A Kaa developer is able to add, update and delete log appenders using [Admin UI](#) or [REST API](#). Kaa provides several default implementations of log appenders but it is also possible to create custom log appenders.
